



WHAT DOES DERBYSHIRE COUNTY ARCHERY ASSOCIATION (DCAA) DO FOR YOU?

Archery GB's rules state that all Archery GB members must join their County and Region Associations. Currently, you will pay £5 to DCAA with your AGB membership every year, but what do you get for your money?

You may be aware that the committee meets during the year but not know what is discussed and what happens outside of the meetings. Here is a brief outline of the types of activities and responsibilities that DCAA have:

- Coaching – Organising the six Winter Coaching sessions for all members, organisation of recognised coaching qualifications.
- Teams – Selecting archers to represent Derbyshire at inter-county competitions and provides a Team shirt.
- Equipment – Providing a library of beginner equipment to borrow.
- Records – Verifying and keeping records of new County records for every AGB recognised round.
- Safeguarding – Providing a point of contact for concerns and ensures clubs adhere to AGB policy.
- Website – Providing news and information on competitions, club information and contact points, records, documentation.
- Development – A separate team who work to help develop the sport, and to work together with other national and local sporting bodies and organisations on the development of archery within the County.
- Competitions – Organising three County competitions throughout the year and involvement in Regional competitions, with Derbyshire hosting these on a rota with other Counties in the region.
- Leagues – Organising both Summer and Winter Leagues for all Derbyshire clubs.
- Representation at Regional Meetings – Providing delegates to attend all East Midlands Archery Society (EMAS) meetings to forward County decisions and represent Derbyshire.
- Finance – Overseeing the income and expenditure of the County, including grants to UK/England representatives and new clubs.
- Membership – Holding membership information and liaises with Region on numbers
